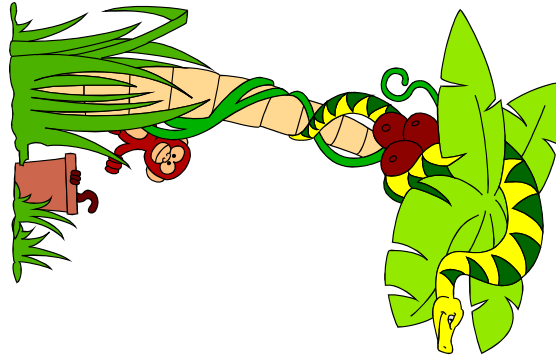

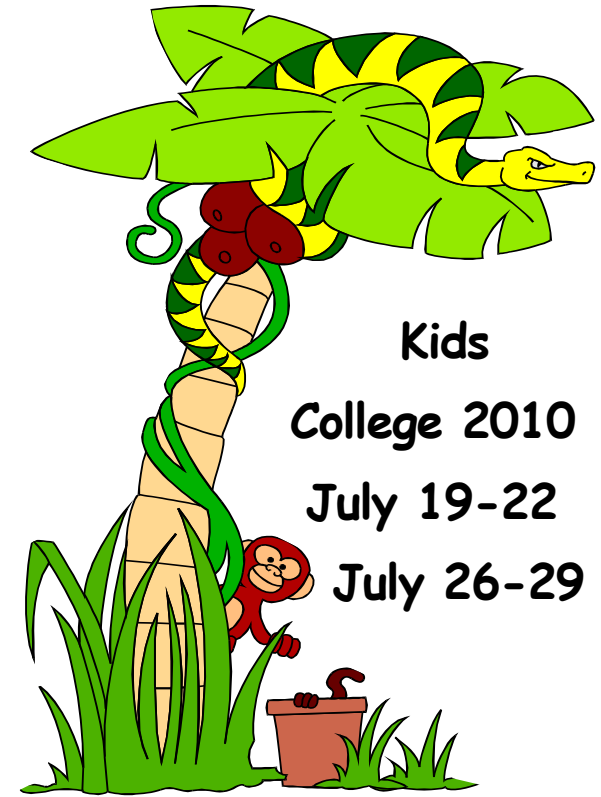

Course Descriptions

Archery-Bow-up
